

Pitts Domain Program Overview

The Pitts Domain Program provides web hosting space and a domain name to Candler School of Theology applicants to establish a personal presence online or to develop a digital project.

Approved participants will receive one free year of web hosting space and one free domain name through Reclaim Hosting. Participants can re-apply in subsequent years to maintain their subsidized hosting.

Applications are currently open to Candler students, faculty, and staff.

Submit an Application

The number of participants is limited and applications are reviewed on a rolling basis by the Systems and Digital Scholarship Librarian, Spencer Roberts. Participants will work with Pitts staff to set up and maintain the hosting space.

Participants are also required to attend quarterly workshops to discuss their projects, receive additional training as needed, and provide feedback about the program.

Participants who leave Candler or who are not approved for additional years can continue using their Reclaim space at their own expense. The current annual cost is \$30.

Participation in this program is subject to approval by Pitts Theology Library.

Participants must acknowledge and accept the following:

- 1. a successful application is valid for one year of free service through Reclaim Hosting
- 2. additional years of free service will require another application
- 3. participants who leave Candler or who are not approved for additional years can continue using their Reclaim space at their own expense
- 4. participants must attend quarterly workshops to discuss their projects, receive additional training as needed, and provide feedback about the program
